

OFFICE HOURS AND LOCATION & HANDICAPPED

PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 2-2-114A of the Tennessee Election Laws, the Grainger County Election Commission office is located in the old post office building at 119 Marshall Ave., in Rutledge, TN. Office hours are Monday – Friday 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. Election Commission will be open on Saturday, February 4th, from 8:30 to 12:00. This is the Saturday before the registration deadline of February 6th.

PURSUANT TO CODE SECTION 2-3-109e of the Tennessee Election Laws, notice is hereby given that if any elderly voter or voter with a disability voters polling place is inaccessible, such voter has the right to vote “early”, “by absentee ballot,” or, at the Election Commission office on March 6, 2012 for the PPP/County Primaries. Voter shall complete an affidavit at the Election Commission office stating that such voter’s designated polling place does not comply with the provisions of the Public Law 98-435. The affidavit must be received by the county Election Commission office by February 25, 2012. The Election Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability. If there are questions about needed accommodations in the voting process, please call our office.
